TIRAMISU BABY BLANKET

With a subtle tiramisu color palette and a classic pattern stitch, this yummy blanket is likely to be cherished for years.

Skill Level: Beginner

Finished Dimensions: 32"
square

Yarn: Blue Sky Alpacas Organic Cotton, a 100% cotton worsted weight yarn packaged in 100 g skeins containing 150 yds: 7 skeins of 80 Bone

Hook Size: 5.5 mm/U.S. I-9

Other Materials: 5 yds of 1/2"
wide ribbon



Gauge: 12 sts and 13 rows = 4" in sc
To save time, please check your gauge.

Directions:

Ch 91.

Foundation Row (RS): Sc in 3rd ch from hook, (sk next ch, 2 sc in next ch) to end of ch. (90 sts)
Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sk first sc, 2 sc in next sc; (sk next sc, 2 sc in next sc) across to end of row. Turn.

Repeat Row 2 until blanket is 30" from bottom.

Edging

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each sc across to end last row, 2 more sc in last sc (corner turned), work 88 sc evenly across left edge, 3 sc in bottom loop of foundation chain (corner turned), sc in bottom loop of each ch across, 2 more sc in last loop (corner turned), work 88 sc evenly across right edge, 1 more sc in last sp, join with sl st to first sc of round (corner turned). [364 sts (88 per side, with 3 in each corner)]

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch-1 sp), *(sk 1 sc, dc in next sc, ch 1) to corner, (dc in

same sc, ch 1) 2 times more (corner turned), repeat from * for next three sides of blanket, only repeating last (dc in same sc, ch1) one time in last corner. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-4.

Rnd 3: (Sk ch-1 sp, 5 dc in next dc, sk ch-1 sp, sl st in next dc) around entire edge of blanket.
Fasten off.

To finish, weave ribbon through dcs and tie in bow at corner.
